

CANAL FOOTBRIDGE OPTION 2



OPTION 2 - NORTH

Option 2 shows a new crossing at the centre of the site and where the levels are least challenging in relation to the proximity of the canal.

The photograph above illustrates the relatively gentle slopes to the north and south of canal. This means that the level on each side of the canal is almost the same, with a slight slope up in the south and a slight slope down to the north.

As any bridge over requires a clearance or headroom of approximately 3m it would sit much higher than the existing ground level. However due to this location being furthest away from the houses on Maidlands in the west and the farmhouse in the east, there are less issues with overlooking and privacy to existing properties. The length of the bridge in this location would be longer at approx. 43m
